

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PACKAGE

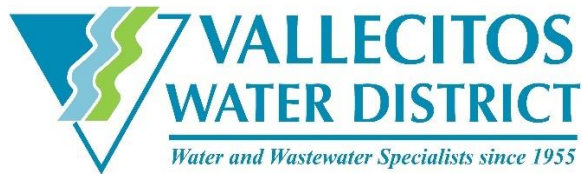
Vallecitos Water District (VWD) invites Palomar College students, California State San Marcos students, and local high school seniors to compete for scholarship(s) from VWD. Up to six scholarships may be awarded in amounts up to \$2,000 per scholarship. Winners will be selected based on the quality and originality of an essay prepared by the applicant as well as demonstrated school and community involvement. Applications will not be accepted if all criteria are not met. **Applicants must submit each of the following documents by 5:00 PM on Friday, March 29, 2024:**

1. Completed application form.
2. A letter of recommendation from a faculty member or a personal or professional associate.
3. An essay (maximum two pages). Suggested topics include the student's reasons for applying for the scholarship, the student's educational/career goals, personal background, or interests.
4. A financial needs worksheet (one page maximum). The financial needs assessment should outline how the scholarship will be used.
