



James Gumpel appointed General Manager of the Vallecitos Water District starting January 1, 2024

James Gumpel is the new General Manager of Vallecitos Water District. He began his new duties on January 1, 2024.

James was born in 1973 in Uijeongbu, South Korea (same location as the fictional 4077th hospital on the television show M*A*S*H) at the army base where his father was stationed. During his childhood he lived in Korea, Japan, the Bronx, Yonkers, and finally in California where he lived in Los Angeles and then Camarillo, where he attended middle and high school.

James graduated from San Diego State University with a Civil Engineering degree. After college, he worked in the private sector for five years focusing on water, wastewater, and recycled water projects.

He joined the Otay Water District in 2000 and worked there for about five years before joining Vallecitos on May 16, 2005. James was initially the Capital Facilities/Construction Engineer before being promoted to Principal Engineer, District Engineer and more recently to Assistant General Manager.



One of the larger projects that James oversaw during his career at Vallecitos was the design and construction of the 40-million-gallon Twin Oaks Reservoir #2 (TOR2). At the time of its completion, TOR2 was the largest prestressed concrete tank in the world.

James is an avid skier, sailor, mountain biker, and coaches' youth baseball. He is married to his wife Melissa, and they live with their three children in San Marcos.

Vallecitos Videos Win National EPA WaterSense Award

Water Sense 2023 PART NER YEAR

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has honored the Vallecitos Water District with a WaterSense Partner of the Year Award for its video series promoting WaterSense and water efficiency in 2022.

WaterSense partners contribute to the program's success by enhancing the market for water-efficient products, practices, and services. Each year WaterSense recognizes those partners who have gone above and beyond in supporting WaterSense.

Vallecitos was one of nine Partner of the Year Award winners across the U.S. Awards were presented at the American Water Works Association Water Smart Innovations event in Las Vegas on October 5, 2023.

WaterSense is a voluntary partnership program sponsored by the EPA. It identifies and labels water-efficient products, programs, and homes to help consumers learn ways to save water. More than 2,100 manufacturers, builders, retailers, utilities, government, and nonprofit organizations partner with WaterSense to promote water-efficient products, homes, and programs.

Vallecitos produced twelve videos released monthly in 2022, based on the EPA's monthly feature topics. Each video focused on educating consumers about creating a WaterSense home. Among the topics covered by the 12 videos in

Vallecitos began using video in 2019 to document the district's workforce and infrastructure improvements on its social media platforms and has also engaged the public with discussions of critically important water management issues.


