E – MRF Conversion to Sodium Hypochlorite Project

<u>Description</u> - The Meadowlark Water Reclamation Facility (MRF) currently uses 100% chlorine gas as a disinfectant to meet State regulations for treatment to reclaimed water standards. Chlorine gas is an acute hazard that presents a danger to District staff and the residents in the immediate area. Use of chlorine gas requires the District to maintain several extensive State and Federal safety programs, equipment, and a Hazardous Materials response team. The conversion from chlorine gas to bulk storage of sodium hypochlorite removes the acute hazard and replaces it with storage and injection of bleach solution (12.5%). Use of the bleach disinfectant does not create an acute hazard in the event of a spill.
